



Proof of Vaccination-Vaccine Card-FAQs

By order of the Provincial and Regional Health Officers, proof of two-doses of COVID-19 vaccination is required to access some events, services, and businesses. All people accessing the North Peace Gymnastics facility must follow the requirements outlines in the Provincial Face Coverings and Gathering and Events Orders, as well as the Northern Health Gathering and Events Order. The Proof of Vaccination requirement will stay in place till November 19, 2021 or when the order is lifted by the Provincial Health Officers.

What if my child is not vaccinated?

- Children and youth 12-21 participating in children and youth sport activities are exempt from the Vaccine Passport requirements

What if I am unvaccinated but my child is in a drop off class?

- NPGA will remain a closed and locked facility with coaches meeting participants at the exterior doors. Due to parents not entering the facility there are no changes to these classes.

If my child is 3-5 years old and has been attending Drop-in Play that requires parent participation, can I switch them to a drop off Active Start program?

- We would love to find a class that works for your family. We have several classes that have availability and will work with your family so that your child can continue with gymnastics.

Why is there a parent/guardian entering the facility with my child's drop off class?

- NPGA is committed to offering inclusive, dynamic and adaptable programming for all. Through out the session we have medically vulnerable children participating in programming and NPGA's staff are not trained or equipped to handle their needs. Parent and caregivers join these children to ensure their medical needs are met.
