1.0 Purpose:

The purpose of the Registration and Refund Policy is to provide guidelines for athlete registration and refunds for programs offered by North Peace Gymnastics Association.

2.0 Registration:

2.1 Registration is accepted on a first-come first serve basis. Payments must be up to date for your athlete to be permitted on the floor. Returned payments will be charged an NSF fee of \$25.00.

2.2 Classes with insufficient registrants are subject to cancellation or we may choose to combine classes. Therefore, class dates and times are subject to change.

3.0 Refunds:

3.1 Refunds may only be issued within the first 2 weeks of the session. No refund will be issued after the second class except in the event of an injury or serious illness and only if a doctor's note is presented.

3.2 Refunds or credits will not be issued for those missing class due to injury, illness or other sicknesses related reasons.

3.3 Please allow up to 3 weeks to process a refund.

3.4 Refunds may be issued through the registration system or by cheque

3.5 A \$25.00 administration charge will be retained by NPGA.

4.0 Gymnastics BC Membership Fee

4.1 The GymBC Membership fee and Zone 8 Membership fee are non-refundable. All gymnasts are required to register with GymBC and Zone 8. This annual fee covers a gymnast from September 1 to August 31 (annually). It is non-refundable even if the gymnast is required to leave for medical reasons or the facility is due to shut down do to circumstances outside of NPGA's control.
